I-405 Ramp Closures in San Fernando Valley Scheduled for Pavement Work and Sound Wall Project

Project to Enhance Safety

LOS ANGELES — The California Department of Transportation (Caltrans) will temporarily close the Victory Boulevard off-ramp of the southbound San Diego Freeway (I-405) in Van Nuys to do pavement work, install a concrete barrier railing and realign part of a sound wall.

The following schedule will be in effect, weather permitting, and is subject to change:

Monday, April 25 through Friday, April 29

Southbound I-405 only:

- 10 a.m. to 3 p.m. – Victory Boulevard off ramp closure.

Highland Construction, Inc. of Orange is the contractor on this project, which is designed to enhance safety by realigning a portion of the sound wall near the off ramp. The project also includes installation of a concrete barrier railing, upgrading the lighting system and widening the ramp terminus of the southbound off ramp.

The temporary ramp closures are necessary for safety during the construction phase of the project. The ramp closures for this project are scheduled to end by mid-September.
