CONSTRUCTION NOTICE: June 11 to June 22

WHAT

Caltrans will continue widening the northbound and southbound US 101, La Conchita Pedestrian Overcrossing, and widen Bates Road in Ventura and Santa Barbara.

WHERE

Northbound and southbound US 101 between Mobil Pier Road to Casitas Pass Road in median in several locations.

WHAT TO EXPECT

Daytime

Dates: Monday, June 11 through Friday, June 22, 2012

Hours: 7 a.m. to 3:30 p.m.

Work:

Ventura County

- La Conchita Pedestrian Undercrossing: place pavement and restripe the median. Pedestrian access to the beach will be closed.

Santa Barbara County

- Bates Road Overcrossing: continue widening the bridge and place concrete in the two retaining walls. Flagmen will be utilized when necessary.
- US 101 Median: crews will clear debris and begin constructing the retaining wall.

Dates: Daily, Monday, June 11 through Thursday, June 14, 2012

Hours: Northbound US 101 from 9 a.m. to 1 p.m.

Southbound US 101 from 9:30 a.m. to 1 p.m.

Work: Ventura County: crews will survey the area.

Closures: Northbound and southbound US 101, one lane closed in each direction between La Conchita and Bates Road.

Overnight

Dates: Nightly, Sunday, June 17 and Monday, June 18, 2012

Hours: Northbound and southbound US 101 from 7 p.m. to 6 a.m.

Work: Ventura County: crews will reset k-rail and stripe the roadway.

Closures: Northbound and southbound US 101, one lane closed in each direction between La Conchita and Bates Road in.

ABOUT THE PROJECT

The project is constructing a six-mile carpool lane in each direction for vehicles with two or more passengers, along US 101 from Mobil Pier Road in Ventura County to Casitas Pass Road in Santa Barbara County. Additional improvements include: a pedestrian undercrossing in La Conchita, concrete barriers, southbound bike lane, median landscaping, reconstruction of existing drainage, closing existing median openings and installing Intelligent Transportation Systems.
