

Avenue of the Giants Four Bridges Project FACT SHEET

The Project

The Avenue of the Giants Four Bridges Project will replace bridge rails at four locations on Route 254, a 32-mile long segment of old Highway 101 designated as the "Avenue of the Giants." It is a scenic alternative to Route 101 that runs parallel to the Eel River through the Humboldt Redwoods State Park. The project includes the following four bridge locations:

- Ohman Creek Bridge
- Elk Creek Bridge
- Bridge Creek Bridge
- Bear Creek Bridge

Benefits

The proposed railing upgrade will bring the bridge rails to current standards.

Project Status

Environmental studies are currently under development for this project.

Project Costs

The current project cost estimate is \$9.7 million.

Project Schedule


