

Caltrans Projects in Tuolumne County

Caltrans has a number of road projects coming to Tuolumne County that will help improve regional mobility, reduce congestion and provide a smooth ride:

1: State Route-120 (SR-120)/James E. Roberts Memorial Bridge Project

Replaces the bridge deck and railings, provides a seismic retrofit to the structure. The \$20.8 million project begins in July 2016.

2: SR-108/Long Barn-Cold Springs Paving Project Applies a 1-inch layer of asphalt to 14 miles of SR-108, at locations between Long Barn and Eagle Meadows Road. The \$2 million project is scheduled to start in August 2016.

3: SR-108 & SR-120/Stanislaus-Tuolumne Paving Project

Applies a 2-inch layer of asphalt to 34 miles of SR-108 and SR-120, from Lancaster Road in Stanislaus County to Moccasin Creek Bridge (SR-120) and Montezuma Road (SR-108) in Tuolumne County. The \$35.4 million project is scheduled to begin in Spring 2018.

4: SR-108 West Long Barn CAPM

Applies a 2.5-inch layer of asphalt on two miles of SR-120, from Lyons Dam Road to Long Barn Road. The \$1.6 million project is scheduled to start in Spring 2018.

5: SR-120/Vehicle Turnouts

Creates three turnouts for eastbound vehicles heading uphill on SR-120/New Priest Grade Road. The \$1 million project is scheduled to begin in Spring 2018.

6: SR-108 & SR-120/Rumble Strip Installation

Applies rumble strips at various locations on SR-108 and SR-120, from the Tuolumne/Stanislaus County line to Clarks Fork Road, east of Dardanelle. The \$1.1 million project is scheduled to start in Fall 2018.

7: SR-49/Rumble Strip Installation

Applies rumble strips at various locations on SR-49, from the Tuolumne/Mariposa County line to the Tuolumne/Calaveras County line. The \$1.6 million project is scheduled to start in Spring 2019.

8: SR-108/Peaceful Oak Ramps Project

Constructs a westbound off-ramp and eastbound on-ramp at the Peaceful Oaks Road Interchange. The \$9.8 million project is scheduled to begin in 2019. Ilion project is scheduled to begin in 2019.

9: SR-120 & SR-108/Intersection Improvement Project

Upgrades Yosemite Junction at SR-120/SR-108, adding a roundabout or a traffic signal. The \$6.7 million project is still in the planning process and a start date has yet to be determined.

This work is scheduled to begin as listed, but is subject to change due to traffic incidents, weather, availability of equipment and/ or materials and construction related issues.
