TRAFFIC ADVISORY STATE ROUTE 99 IN STANISLAUS COUNTY

Stanislaus County - The California Department of Transportation (Caltrans) will perform highway construction and work on the medians and bridges on State Route 99 (SR-99) from the Stanislaus/ Merced County line to the Stanislaus/ San Joaquin County line. Work will occur at the following locations:

- The on and off-ramps on northbound and southbound SR-99 from the Merced County line to the San Joaquin County line will alternately close beginning Monday, August 20, 2012, through Saturday, August 25, 2012, from 7:00 p.m. until 7:00 a.m.;
- The lanes and shoulders on northbound and southbound SR-99 from the Merced County line to the San Joaquin County line will alternately close beginning Monday, August 20, 2012, through Saturday, August 25, 2012, from 7:00 p.m. until 7:00 a.m.

Motorists should expect 30 minute delays. Alternate routes should be taken whenever possible.

Crews will also close the # 1 (left) lane and median from Kansas Avenue to Carpenter Road/ Briggsmore Road beginning Tuesday, August 21, 2012, through Wednesday, August 22, 2012, from 9:00 a.m. until 2:00 p.m.

Motorists should expect 15 minute delays. Alternate routes should be taken whenever possible.

This work is scheduled to begin as listed, but is subject to change.
