TRAFFIC ADVISORY STATE ROUTE 99 IN STANISLAUS COUNTY

Stanislaus County - The California Department of Transportation (Caltrans) will perform highway construction and electrical work on State Route 99 (SR-99) from the Stanislaus/Merced County line to the Stanislaus/San Joaquin County line. Work will occur at the following locations:

- The northbound and southbound on and off-ramps from SR-99 to Taylor Road will alternately close beginning Monday, December 3, 2012, through Saturday, December 8, 2012, from 7:00 p.m. to 9:00 a.m.;
- The northbound and southbound on and off-ramps on SR-99 from Taylor Road to Whitmore Avenue will close beginning Monday, December 3, 2012, through Saturday, December 8, 2012, from 7:00 p.m. until 7:00 a.m.;
- The northbound off-ramp from SR-99 to Beckwith Road will close on Monday, December 3, 2012, from 7:00 a.m. until 3:00 p.m.;
- The northbound and southbound on and off-ramps from SR-99 to Hammett Road will alternately close beginning Monday, December 3, 2012, through Saturday, December 8, 2012, from 7:00 a.m. until 6:00 p.m.;

- The #2 (center) and #3 (right) lanes and right shoulder on northbound and southbound SR-99 from the Merced County line to the San Joaquin County line will alternately close beginning Monday, December 3, 2012, through Saturday, December 8, 2012, from 7:00 p.m. until 5:30 a.m.

Motorists should expect 30 minute delays. Alternate routes should be taken whenever possible.

This work is scheduled to begin as listed, but is subject to change due to traffic incidents, weather, availability of equipment and/or materials and construction related issues.
