TRAFFIC ADVISORY STATE ROUTE 99 IN STANISLAUS COUNTY

Stanislaus County - The California Department of Transportation (Caltrans) will perform highway construction on State Route 99 (SR-99) from the Stanislaus/ Merced County line to the Stanislaus/ San Joaquin County line. Work will occur at the following locations:

- The on and off-ramps on northbound and southbound SR-99 from the Merced County line to Lander Avenue and from Mitchell Road to the San Joaquin County line will alternately close beginning Monday, July 16, 2012, through Saturday, July 21, 2012, from 6:00 p.m. until 10:00 a.m.;
- The #2 (center) and # 3 (right) lanes and right shoulder on northbound and southbound SR-99 from the Merced County line to Lander Avenue and from Mitchell Road to the San Joaquin County line will close beginning Monday, July 16, 2012, through Saturday, July 21, 2012, from 7:00 p.m. until 6:00 a.m.;

No work is scheduled to occur from Lander Avenue to Mitchell Road this week.

Motorists should expect 30 minute delays. Alternate routes should be taken whenever possible.

This work is scheduled to begin as listed, but is subject to change.
