### TRAFFIC ADVISORY INTERSTATE 5 NEAR STOCKTON

**San Joaquin County** - The California Department of Transportation (Caltrans) will pave, stripe the roadway and perform bridgework on Interstate 5 (I-5) from Pershing Avenue to the San Joaquin/ Sacramento County line. No two consecutive ramps will be closed at one time. Work will occur at the following locations:

- The northbound and southbound on and off-ramps at Pershing Avenue and Oak Street/ Fremont Street will alternately close beginning Sunday, July 22, 2012, through Saturday, July 28, 2012, from 9:00 p.m. until 5:00 a.m.;
- The lanes on northbound and southbound I-5 from Hammer Lane to the San Joaquin/ Sacramento County line will alternately close beginning Sunday, July 22, 2012, through Friday, July 27, 2012, from 9:00 p.m. until 6:00 a.m.

Motorists should expect 15 minute delays. Alternate routes should be taken whenever possible.

This work is scheduled to begin as listed, but is subject to change.
