### TRAFFIC ADVISORY INTERSTATE 5 NEAR STOCKTON

**Stockton** - The California Department of Transportation (Caltrans) will perform routine bridge maintenance, electrical repairs, repair pavement, drive piles and install bridge falsework and lighting on Interstate 5 (I-5) from State Route 4 (SR-4)/Crosstown Freeway to the San Joaquin/Sacramento County line. No two consecutive ramps will be closed at the same time. Work will occur at the following locations:

- The #2 (right) lane on the connector ramp from westbound SR-4 to northbound I-5, the on-ramp from Center Street to westbound SR-4 and the off-ramp from northbound I-5 to Pershing Avenue will close on Monday, April 2, 2012, from 8:00 a.m. until 3:00 p.m.;
- The connector ramp from southbound I-5 to westbound SR-4 and the southbound on-ramp from Oak/Fremont Street will close on Tuesday, April 3, 2012, from 8:00 a.m. until 3:00 p.m.;
- The connector ramps from SR-4 to northbound I-5 and southbound I-5 to SR-4 will close beginning Sunday, April 1, 2012, through Friday, April 6, 2012, from 9:00 p.m. until 5:00 a.m.;
- The #1 (left) and #2 (right) lanes on eastbound and westbound Country Club Boulevard under I-5 will alternately close beginning Monday, April 2, 2012, through Friday, April 6, 2012, from 9:00 a.m. until 2:00 p.m.;
- Telegraph Avenue under I-5 will operate at one-way traffic control beginning Monday, April 2, 2012, through Friday, April 6, 2012, from 9:00 a.m. until 2:00 p.m.;

- The on and off-ramps on northbound and southbound I-5 from SR-4 to the San Joaquin/Sacramento County line will alternately close beginning Sunday, April 1, 2012, through Friday, April 6, 2012, from 7:00 p.m. until 6:00 a.m.; and
- The lanes on northbound and southbound I-5 from SR-4 to the San Joaquin/Sacramento County line will alternately close beginning Sunday, April 1, 2012, through Friday, April 6, 2012, from 8:00 p.m. until 6:00 a.m.

Motorists should expect 20 minute delays. Alternate routes should be taken whenever possible.

This work is scheduled to begin as listed, but is subject to change.
