TRAFFIC ADVISORY INTERSTATE 5 IN SAN JOAQUIN COUNTY

San Joaquin County - The California Department of Transportation (Caltrans) will perform routine bridge maintenance and repair pavement on Interstate 5 (I-5) from State Route 4 (SR-4) to the San Joaquin/Sacramento County Line. No two consecutive ramps will be closed at the same time. Work will occur at the following locations:

- The northbound and southbound lanes on I-5 from SR-4 to Pershing Avenue will alternately close beginning Sunday, May 13, 2012, through Friday, May 18, 2012, from 8:00 p.m. until 5:00 a.m.;
- The connector ramps from SR-4 (Crosstown Freeway) to I-5 will alternately close beginning Sunday, May 13, 2012, through Friday, May 18, 2012, from 8:00 p.m. until 5:00 a.m.;
- The northbound and southbound on and off-ramps from SR-4 to Turner Road/Walnut Grove will close beginning Sunday, May 13, 2012, through Friday, May 18, 2012, from 8:00 p.m. until 5:00 a.m.; and
- The northbound and southbound #2 (right) lanes on I-5 from SR-12 to the San Joaquin/Sacramento County Line will close beginning Monday, May 14, 2012, through Friday, May 18, 2012, from 8:00 p.m. until 6:00 a.m.

Motorists should expect 20 minute delays. Alternate routes should be taken whenever possible.

This work is scheduled to begin as listed, but is subject to change.
