TRAFFIC ADVISORY STATE ROUTE 99 IN STANISLAUS COUNTY

Stanislaus County - The California Department of Transportation (Caltrans) will replace the pavement and reconstruct the on and off-ramps on State Route 99 (SR-99) from the Stanislaus/ San Joaquin County Line to the Stanislaus/ Merced County Line. No two consecutive ramps will be closed at one time. Work will occur at the following locations:

- The north and southbound on and off-ramps from Taylor Road to Hatch Road will alternately close beginning Tuesday, May 29, 2012, through Saturday, June 2, 2012, from 7:00 p.m. until 9:00 a.m.;
- The lanes on northbound and southbound SR-99 from the Stanislaus/ San Joaquin County Line to the Stanislaus/ Merced County Line will alternately close beginning Tuesday, May 29, 2012, through Saturday, June 2, 2012, from 7:00 p.m. until 7:00 a.m.;
- The southbound on and off-ramps at Tuolumne Boulevard are closed from Sunday, May 6, 2012, through Saturday, June 2, 2012.

Motorists should expect 30 minute delays. Alternate routes should be taken whenever possible.

This work is scheduled to begin as listed, but is subject to change.
