TRAFFIC ADVISORY INTERSTATE 5 NEAR STOCKTON

Stockton - The California Department of Transportation (Caltrans) will perform routine bridge maintenance, install k-rail and install bridge falsework and lighting on Interstate 5 (I-5) from State Route 4 (SR-4)/ Crosstown Freeway to San Joaquin/ Sacramento County line. No two consecutive ramps will be closed at the same time. Work will occur at the following locations:

- The connector ramps from SR-4 to I-5 will alternately close beginning Tuesday, May 29, 2012, at 5:00 a.m. until Wednesday, May 30, 2012, at 7:00 p.m.;
- The lanes on northbound and southbound I-5 from SR-4 to the San Joaquin/ Sacramento County line will alternately close beginning Tuesday, May 29, 2012, until Friday, June 1, 2012, from 7:00 p.m. through 5:00 a.m.;
- The #1 (left) lane from SR-4/ Dr. Martin Luther King Jr. Boulevard to just south of Pershing Avenue will close beginning Wednesday, May 30, 2012, to Thursday, May 31, 2012, from 9:00 a.m. to 4:00 p.m.;
- The northbound off-ramp from I-5 to Pershing Avenue will close beginning Tuesday, May 29, 2012, at 5:00 a.m. until Wednesday, May 30, 2012 at 9:00 p.m.;
- The lanes on Country Club Boulevard under I-5 will alternately close beginning Tuesday, May 29, 2012 through Friday, June 1, 2012 from 9 a.m. until 2 p.m.;
- The #1 (left) lane from County Club Boulevard to Hammer Lane on northbound I-5 will close beginning Thursday, May 31, 2012 to Friday, June 1, 2012, from 9:00 a.m. to 11:00 a.m.;

- Telegraph Avenue under I-5 will operate under one-way traffic control beginning Tuesday, May 29, 2012 through Friday, June 1, 2012, from 9:00 a.m. to 2:00 p.m.;
- The lanes on Benjamin Holt Drive under I-5 will alternately close beginning Tuesday, May 29, 2012, through Friday, June 1, 2012, from 9:00 a.m. to 2:00 p.m.

Motorists should expect 20 minute delays. Alternate routes should be taken whenever possible.

This work is scheduled to begin as listed, but is subject to change.
