TRAFFIC ADVISORY STATE ROUTE 99 FROM STATE ROUTE 120/ YOSEMITE AVENUE TO CLARK DRIVE IN SAN JOAQUIN COUNTY

San Joaquin County - The California Department of Transportation (Caltrans) will perform roadway excavation and grinding on State Route 99 (SR-99) from State Route 120 (SR-120)/ Yosemite Avenue to Clark Drive.

Work will occur at the following locations:

- The #1 (left) and #2 (right) lanes on northbound and southbound SR-99 from SR-120/ Yosemite Avenue to Arch Road will alternately close beginning Monday, October 29, 2012, through Thursday, November 1, 2012, from 8:00 p.m. until 5:00 a.m.;
- The southbound off-ramp from SR-99 to North Manteca/ Main Street will close beginning Monday, October 29, 2012, through Friday, November 2, 2012, from 9:00 p.m. until 5:00 a.m.;
- The #2 (right) lane on northbound SR-99 from Arch Road to Duck Creek (Mariposa Road) will close beginning Monday, October 29, 2012, through Wednesday, October 31, 2012, from 8:30 a.m. until 12:30 p.m.;

- The northbound off-ramp from SR-99 to Clark Drive will close beginning Monday, October 29, 2012, through Wednesday, October 31, 2012, from 8:30 a.m. until 12:30 p.m.

Motorists should expect 15 minute delays. Alternate routes should be taken whenever possible.

This work is scheduled to begin as listed, but is subject to change due to traffic incidents, weather, availability of equipment and/or materials and construction related issues.
