TRAFFIC ADVISORY STATE ROUTE 99 IN STANISLAUS COUNTY

Stanislaus County - The California Department of Transportation (Caltrans) will perform highway construction on State Route 99 (SR-99) from Taylor Road to Hammett Road. Work will occur at the following locations:

- The northbound and southbound on and off-ramps, # 2 (center) and # 3 (right) lanes and right shoulder on SR-99 from Taylor Road to Hatch Road will close beginning Monday, September 17, 2012, through Saturday, September 22, 2012, from 7:00 p.m. until 7:00 a.m.;
- Various on and off-ramps on SR-99 at Taylor Road will close beginning Monday, September 17, 2012, through Saturday, September 22, 2012, from 7:00 p.m. until 10:00 a.m.;
- Various on and off-ramps on SR-99 at Whitmore Avenue will close beginning Monday, September 17, 2012, through Saturday, September 22, 2012, from 7:00 p.m. until 7:00 a.m.;
- The # 2 (center) and # 3 (right) lanes and right shoulder on SR-99 from Hatch Road to the Stanislaus/ San Joaquin County line will close beginning Monday, September 17, 2012, through Saturday, September 22, 2012, from 7:00 p.m. until 5:30 a.m.;

- The northbound and southbound on and off-ramps on SR-99 at Hammett Road will close beginning Monday, September 17, 2012, through Saturday, September 22, 2012, from 7:00 p.m. until 6:00 a.m.

Motorists should expect 30 minute delays. Alternate routes should be taken when possible.

This work is scheduled to begin as listed, but is subject to change due to traffic incidents, weather, availability of equipment and/or materials and construction related issues.
