TRAFFIC ADVISORY STATE ROUTE 99 FROM MARIPOSA CREEK TO THE MERCED/ STANISLAUS COUNTY LINE IN MERCED COUNTY

Merced County – The California Department of Transportation (Caltrans) will perform various road construction activities and bridge work on State Route 99 (SR-99) from Mariposa Creek to the Merced/ Stanislaus County line. Work will occur as follows:

- The #1 (left) and #2 (right) lanes on SR-99 from Mariposa Creek to the Merced/ Stanislaus County line will alternately close beginning Monday, October 1, 2012, through Friday, October 5, 2012, from 8:30 a.m. until 2:30 p.m.;
- The northbound off-ramp from SR-99 to Westside Boulevard/ Central Avenue will close beginning Monday, October 1, 2012, through Thursday, October 4, 2012, from 6:00 a.m. until 6:00 p.m.;
- The southbound off-ramp from SR-99 to 16th Street will close on Tuesday, October 2, 2012, at 8:00 p.m. and is scheduled to reopen March 1, 2013;
- The southbound on-ramp from SR-99 to 16th Street closed on Friday, August 24, 2012 and is scheduled to reopen Monday, December 31, 2012;
- The northbound on-ramp from SR-99 to SR-140/ near 15th Street, and the southbound on-ramp from G Street to SR-99 are closed and scheduled to reopen May 6, 2013.

Motorists should expect 15 minute delays. Alternate routes should be taken whenever possible.
