TRAFFIC ADVISORY STATE ROUTE 99 FROM MARIPOSA ROAD TO STATE ROUTE 26/FREMONT STREET IN STOCKTON

Stockton - The California Department of Transportation (Caltrans) will alternately close the northbound and southbound on and off-ramps on State Route 99 (SR-99), from Mariposa Road to SR-26/Fremont Street for various construction activities. No two consecutive ramps will be closed at one time. Work will occur as follows:

- The northbound on and off-ramps from Mariposa Road to SR-99 will alternately close beginning Sunday, September 15, 2013, through Friday, September 20, 2013, from 9:00 p.m. until 4:00 a.m.;
- The northbound off-ramps on SR-99 from SR-4 (Crosstown Freeway) to SR-26/Fremont Street will close beginning Sunday, September 15, 2013, through Friday, September 6, 2013 from 8:00 p.m. until 6:00 a.m.;
- The northbound on-ramp from SR-26/East Fremont Street to SR-99 will close beginning Sunday, September 15, 2013, through Tuesday, September 17, 2013, from 8:00 p.m. until 6:00 a.m.;
- The northbound off-ramp from SR-99 to SR-26/Fremont Street will close beginning Monday, September 15, 2103, through Friday, September 20, 2013, from 8:00 p.m. until 6:00 a.m.
