### **TRAFFIC ADVISORY STATE ROUTE 99 FROM STANISLAUS/SAN JOAQUIN COUNTY LINE TO CHARTER WAY/MAIN STREET IN SAN JOAQUIN COUNTY**

**San Joaquin County** - The California Department of Transportation (Caltrans) will perform highway construction, bridge work and k-rail installation on State Route 99 (SR-99) the Stanislaus/San Joaquin County line to Charter Way/Main Street.

Work will occur at the following locations:

- The #3 (right) lane and right shoulder on northbound SR-99 from the Stanislaus/San Joaquin County line to Jacktone Road will close on Wednesday, April 10, 2013, from 9:00 a.m. until 2:00 p.m.;
- The #1 (left) lane, median and left shoulder on SR-99 from SR-120/Yosemite Avenue to Arch Road will close beginning Sunday, April 7, 2013, through Friday, April 12, 2013, from 8:00 p.m. until 5:00 a.m.;
- The on and off-ramps from SR-99 to Mariposa Road will close beginning Sunday, April 7, 2013, through Friday, April 12, 2013, from 9:00 p.m. until 4:00 a.m.;
- The on and off-ramps from SR-99 to SR-4/Farmington Road will close beginning Sunday, April 7, 2013, through Friday, April 12, 2013, from 9:00 p.m. until 4:00 a.m.;
- Golden Gate Avenue over SR-99 closed on April 8, 2013, and is scheduled to re-open in December 2015.

- The on and off-ramps from southbound SR-99 to Charter Way/Main Street, and the off-ramp from northbound SR-99 to Charter Way/Main Street will close beginning Sunday, April 7, 2013, through Friday, April 12, 2013, from 9:00 p.m. until 4:00 a.m.;
- Southbound SR-99 from Charter Way/Main Street to Mariposa Road will close beginning Tuesday, April 9, 2013, through Friday, April 12, 2013, from 9:00 p.m. until 4:30 a.m.

Motorists should expect 10 to 15 minute delays. Alternate routes should be taken whenever possible.

This work is scheduled to begin as listed, but is subject to change due to traffic incidents, weather, availability of equipment and/or materials and construction related issues.
