TRAFFIC ADVISORY STATE ROUTE 99 FROM THE MERCED/STANISLAUS COUNTY LINE TO THE STANISLAUS/SAN JOAQUIN COUNTY LINE

Stanislaus County – The California Department of Transportation (Caltrans) will perform highway construction on State Route 99 (SR-99) from the Merced/Stanislaus County line to the Stanislaus/San Joaquin County line. No two consecutive ramps will be closed at one time. Work will occur at the following locations:

- The on and off-ramps on northbound and southbound SR-99 from Turlock Rest Area to Hammett Road will alternately close beginning Saturday, June 29, 2013, through Wednesday, July 3, 2013, from 7:00 p.m. until 9:00 a.m.;
- The right shoulder, #2 (center) and #3 (right) lanes on SR-99 from the Merced/Stanislaus County line to the Stanislaus/San Joaquin County line will close beginning Saturday, June 29, 2013, through Wednesday, July 3, 2013, from 7:00 p.m. until 8:00 a.m.

Motorists should expect 30 minute delays. Alternate routes should be taken whenever possible.

This work is scheduled to begin as listed, but is subject to change due to traffic incidents, weather, availability of equipment and/or materials and construction related issues.
