PERMANENT ON-RAMP CLOSURE NORTH MAIN STREET TO STATE ROUTE 99 IN MANTECA

Manteca – The California Department of Transportation (Caltrans) will close the northbound on-ramp from North Main Street to State Route 99 (SR-99) on Monday, July 8, 2013, at 7:00 a.m.

DETOUR:

Northbound -

- Straight on North Main Street;
- Right on Lathrop Road;
- Left on South Frontage Road;
- Take northbound SR-99.

The closure is scheduled to begin as listed, but is subject to change due to traffic incidents, weather, availability of equipment and/ or materials and construction related issues.

This closure is part of the SR-99 Manteca 6-Lane Widening Project. The \$150 million project will widen SR-99 from four to six lanes from just south of SR-120 to just north of Arch Road. The project will also reconstruct the Main Street/Lathrop Road interchange, close the frontage road freeway access near Little John's Creek, and construct sound walls and a median barrier. This phase of the project is scheduled for completion in 2015, and will ease congestion, decrease travel times and improve mobility.
