## **TRAFFIC ADVISORY STATE ROUTE 99 FROM TAYLOR ROAD TO THE STANISLAUS/SAN JOAQUIN COUNTY LINE**

**Stanislaus County** – The California Department of Transportation (Caltrans) will perform highway construction on State Route 99 (SR-99) from Taylor Road to the Stanislaus/San Joaquin County line. No two consecutive ramps will be closed at one time. Work will occur at the following locations:

- The on and off-ramps on northbound and southbound SR-99 from Taylor Road to Hammett Road will alternately close beginning Tuesday, July 9, 2013, through Saturday, July 13, 2013, from 7:00 p.m. until 7:00 a.m.;
- The right shoulder, #2 (center) and #3 (right) lanes on SR-99 from Taylor Road to the Stanislaus/San Joaquin County line will close beginning Tuesday, July 9, 2013, through Saturday, July 13, 2013, from 7:00 p.m. until 7:00 a.m.

Motorists should expect 30 minute delays. Alternate routes should be taken whenever possible.

This work is scheduled to begin as listed, but is subject to change due to traffic incidents, weather, availability of equipment and/or materials and construction related issues.

This work is part of the \$95 million SR-99 Resurfacing and Restoration Project which began in the spring of 2012. The project will resurface and restore 25 miles of the existing pavement on SR-99 from the San Joaquin County line to the Merced County line. This project is anticipated to be completed in 2014.
