TRAFFIC ADVISORY INTERSTATE 580 FROM CHRISMAN ROAD TO THE SAN JOAQUIN/ALAMEDA COUNTY LINE IN SAN JOAQUIN COUNTY

San Joaquin County - The California Department of Transportation (Caltrans) will alternately close the on and off-ramps on Interstate 580 (I-580) from Chrisman Road to the San Joaquin/Alameda County line for pavement striping. No two consecutive ramps will close at the same time. Work will take place as follows:

- The westbound off-ramp from I-580 to Chrisman Road will close beginning Tuesday, November 12, 2013, through Friday, November 15, 2013, from 8:00 a.m. until 4:00 p.m.;
- The eastbound on-ramp to I-580 from Chrisman Road will close beginning Tuesday, November 12, 2013, at 9:00 a.m. until 2:00 p.m.;
- The eastbound on-ramp to I-580 from Chrisman Road will close beginning Wednesday, November 13, 2013, through Friday, November 15, 2013, from 6:00 a.m. until 2:00 p.m.;
- The eastbound on and off-ramps from I-580 to the Corral Hollow Overcrossing will close beginning Tuesday, November 12, 2013, through Friday, November 15, 2013 from 6:00 a.m. until 2:00 p.m.;
- The westbound on and off-ramps from I-580 to the Corral Hollow Overcrossing will close beginning Tuesday, November 12, 2013, through Friday, November 15, 2013 from 8:00 a.m. until 4:00 p.m.;
- The eastbound on and off-ramps from I-580 to the Patterson Pass Overcrossing will close beginning Tuesday, November 12, 2013, through Friday, November 15, 2013, from 6:00 a.m. until 2:00 p.m.;
- The westbound on and off-ramps from I-580 to the Patterson Pass Overcrossing will close beginning Tuesday, November 12, 2013, through Friday, November 15, 2013, from 8:00 a.m. until 4:00 p.m.;
