## **TRAFFIC ADVISORY INTERSTATE 5 BETWEEN COUNTRY CLUB BOULEVARD AND MONTE DIABLO AVENUE IN STOCKTON**

**Stockton** – The California Department of Transportation (Caltrans) will perform a traffic shift on Interstate 5 (I-5) beginning at Country Club Boulevard to Monte Diablo Avenue for road construction.

Crews began shifting southbound traffic toward the median just south of Country Club Boulevard the week of Wednesday, November 13, 2013, to allow crews to replace the pavement on the outside lanes.

Crews will begin shifting northbound traffic toward the median just south of Pershing Avenue the week of November 18, 2013, to allow work to occur in the northbound outside lanes. Traffic is expected to remain in this configuration until May 2014.

Motorists should expect no delays. Alternate routes should be taken whenever possible.

This work is scheduled to begin as listed, but is subject to change due to traffic incidents, weather, availability of equipment and/ or materials, and construction related issues.

The \$53.9 million I-5 Rehabilitation Project, which began in May of 2013, will reconstruct the existing eight lanes of freeway from Dr. Martin Luther King Jr. Boulevard/Charter Way to Country Club Boulevard, in Stockton, providing a smoother driving surface and extended pavement life when it's completed in 2015.
