TRAFFIC ADVISORY INTERSTATE 5 FROM HAMMER LANE TO PERSHING AVENUE IN STOCKTON

Stockton - The California Department of Transportation (Caltrans) will restrict lanes and ramps on Interstate 5 (I-5) from Hammer Lane to Pershing Avenue for maintenance and highway construction. No two consecutive ramps will close at the same time. Work will occur as follows:

- The #1 (left), #2 (middle) and #3 (right) lanes on southbound I-5 from Hammer Lane to Country Club Boulevard will alternately close beginning Monday, April 7, 2014, through Friday, April 11, 2014, from 8:00 p.m. until 5:00 a.m.;
- The southbound on-ramp from March Lane to I-5 will close beginning Monday, April 7, 2014, through Tuesday, April 8, 2014, from 9 a.m. until 2 p.m.;
- The northbound off-ramp from I-5 to March Lane will close beginning Monday, April 7, 2014, through Friday, April 11, 2014, from 10:00 p.m. to 4:00 a.m.;
- The auxiliary lane on southbound I-5 from March Lane to Alpine Avenue will close beginning Monday, April 7, 2014, through Tuesday, April 8, 2014 from 9:00 a.m. until 2:00 p.m.;
- The auxiliary lane on northbound I-5 from Alpine Avenue to March Lane will close beginning Monday, April 7, 2014, through Friday, April 11, 2014, from 8 p.m. until 6:00 a.m.;
- The northbound on-ramp from Alpine Avenue to I-5 will close beginning Monday, April 7, 2014, through Friday, April 11, 2014, from 8:00 p.m. until 5:00 a.m.;
- The northbound on-ramp from Monte Diablo Avenue to I-5 will be closed Monday, April 7, 2014 from 9:00 a.m. until 12:00 p.m. (noon);
- The #3 (right) lane on southbound I-5 from Country Club Boulevard to Pershing Avenue will close beginning Saturday, April 5, 2014, through Monday, April 7, 2014, from 11:00 p.m. until 5:00 a.m.;

- The #1 (left) and #3 (right) lanes, and median on northbound I-5 from Pershing Avenue to Country Club Boulevard will alternately close Monday, April 7, 2014, from 9:00 a.m. until 12:00 p.m. (noon).;

Motorists should expect 10 minute delays. Alternate routes should be taken whenever possible.

This work is scheduled to begin as listed, but is subject to change due to traffic incidents, weather, availability of equipment and/or materials and construction related issues.
