### **TRAFFIC ADVISORY INTERSTATE 5 FROM STATE ROUTE 132 TO COUNTRY CLUB BOULEVARD IN SAN JOAQUIN COUNTY**

**San Joaquin County** – The California Department of Transportation (Caltrans) will perform various road construction and maintenance activities on Interstate 5 (I-5) from State Route 132 (SR-132) to Country Club Boulevard. No two consecutive ramps will close at the same time. Work will occur as follows:

- The connector ramp from eastbound SR-132 to southbound I-5 will close beginning Sunday, August 3, 2014, through Friday, August 8, 2014 from 8:00 p.m. until 6:00 a.m.;
- The #1 (left), #2 (left middle) and #3 (middle) lanes on northbound I-5, just north of Manthey Road, will close beginning Wednesday, August 6, 2014, through Friday, August 8, 2014, from 8:00 p.m. until 6:00 a.m.;
- The #1 (left) and #2 (middle) lanes on southbound I-5 at Roth Road will close beginning Sunday, August 3, 2014, through Friday, August 8, 2014, from 8:00 p.m. until 5:00 a.m.;
- The #1 (left) and #2 (middle) lanes on southbound I-5 at Matthews Road will close beginning Sunday, August 3, 2014, through Friday, August 8, 2014, from 8:00 p.m. until 5:00 a.m.;
- The northbound and southbound on and off-ramps at French Camp Road and I-5 will close beginning Monday, August 4, 2014, through Friday, August 8, 2014, from 9:00 p.m. until 6:00 a.m.;
- The #1 (left) and #2 (middle) lanes on northbound I-5 from French Camp Road to Downing Avenue will close beginning Friday, August 8, 2014, at 8:00 p.m. through Saturday, August 9, 2014, at 7:00 a.m. and Saturday, August 9, 2014, at 9:00 p.m. through Sunday, August 10, 2014, at 9:00 a.m.
- The #2 (middle) and #3 (right) lanes on southbound I-5 from Downing Avenue to Mathews Road will close beginning Monday, August 4, 2014, through Friday, August 8, 2014, from 8:00 p.m. until 6:00 a.m.

- The #1 (left) and #2 (middle) lanes on southbound I-5 from Downing Avenue to French Camp Road will close beginning Friday, August 8, 2014, at 9:00 p.m. through Saturday, August 9, 2014, at 5:00 a.m.;
- The #2 (middle) and #3 (right) lanes on southbound I-5 from Downing Avenue to French Camp Road will close beginning Saturday, August 9, 2014, at 9:00 p.m. through Sunday, August 10, at 8:00 a.m.;
- The #2 (middle) and #3 (right) lanes on northbound I-5 from SR-4/Charter Way to Country Club Boulevard will close beginning Sunday, August 3, 2014, through Friday, August 8, 2014, from 9:00 p.m. until 5:00 a.m.;
- The #2 (middle) and #3 (right) lanes on southbound I-5 from SR-4/Charter Way to Contry Club Boulevard will close beginning Friday, August 8, 2014, through Monday, August 11, 2014, from 9:00 p.m. to 6:00 a.m.;
- The connector ramp from westbound SR-4/Crosstown Freeway to southbound I-5 will close beginning Sunday, August 3, 2014, through Friday, August 8, 2014 from 9:00 p.m. until 4:00 a.m. and Friday, August 8, 2014, at 9:30 p.m. through Monday, August 11, 2014, at 5:00 a.m.;
- The off-ramp from southbound I-5 to State Route 4/Charter Way will close beginning Friday, August 8, 2014, at 9:30 p.m. through Monday, August 11, at 5:00 a.m.
- The connector ramps from northbound and southbound I-5 to SR-4/Charter Way will close beginning Sunday, August 3, 2014, through Friday, August 8, 2014, from 8:00 p.m. until 5:00 a.m.;
- The northbound on-ramp from Monte Diablo Avenue to I-5 is closed and scheduled to reopen Saturday, August 9, 2014;
- The northbound and southbound on and off-ramps at Country Club Boulevard and I-5 will close beginning Sunday, August 3, 2014, through Friday, August 8, 2014, from 9:00 p.m. until 5:00 a.m.

Motorists should expect 15 minute delays. Alternate routes should be taken whenever possible.

This work is scheduled to begin as listed, but is subject to change due to traffic incidents, weather, availability of equipment and/or materials, and construction related issues.
