TRAFFIC ADVISORY STATE ROUTE 140 FROM EDWARDS AVENUE TO SANTA FE AVENUE IN MERCED COUNTY

Merced County – The California Department of Transportation (Caltrans) will intermittently perform one-way traffic control on State Route 140 (SR-140) from Edwards Avenue to Santa Fe Avenue for electrical work.

Work is scheduled to begin Monday, August 18, 2014, through Tuesday, August 19, 2014, from 6:00 a.m. until 5:00 a.m.

Motorists should expect 20 minute delays. Alternate routes should be taken whenever possible.

Work is scheduled to begin as listed, but is subject to change due to traffic incidents, weather, availability of equipment and/ or materials and construction related issues.

This work is part of the \$45.5 million SR-140 Bradley Overhead Project which began on October 26, 2010. The project will replace an existing, aging bridge and widen the roadway from two lanes to four lanes along SR-140. The project begins at Marthella Avenue and ends just east of Santa Fe Avenue. Operational improvements will also include realigning a portion of two major streets and installing two new traffic signal lights.
