### **TRAFFIC ADVISORY STATE ROUTE 99 FROM FRENCH CAMP ROAD IN SAN JOAQUIN COUNTY TO THE SAN JOAQUIN/SACRAMENTO COUNTY LINE**

**San Joaquin County** – The California Department of Transportation (Caltrans) will perform various road construction and maintenance activities on State Route 99 (SR-99) from French Camp Road to San Joaquin/Sacramento County line. No two consecutive ramps will close at the same time. Work will occur as follows:

- The northbound off-ramp from SR-99 to French Camp Road is closed and scheduled to reopen spring 2015;
- The on and off-ramps on northbound and southbound SR-99 at Mariposa Road will close beginning Tuesday, September 2, 2014, through Friday, September 5, 2014, from 9:00 p.m. until 4:00 a.m.;
- The on and off-ramps on northbound and southbound SR-99 at SR-4/East Farmington will close beginning Tuesday, September 2, 2014, through Friday, September 5, 2014, from 9:00 p.m. until 4:00 a.m.;
- The on and off-ramps on southbound SR-99 at Charter Way will close beginning Tuesday, September 2, 2014, through Friday, September 5, 2014, from 10:00 p.m. until 4:00 a.m.;
- The on and off-ramps on northbound SR-99 at Main Street will alternately close beginning Tuesday, September 2, 2014, through Friday, September 5, 2014, from 9:00 p.m. until 4:00 a.m.;
- The median, left shoulder, right shoulder, #1 (left) lane and #2 (right) lane on southbound SR-99 from San Joaquin/Sacramento County Line to Liberty Road will alternately close beginning Tuesday, September 2, 2014, through Friday, September 5, 2014, from 9:00 a.m. until 2:00 p.m.
