TRAFFIC ADVISORY INTERSTATE 5 FROM MANTHEY ROAD TO COUNTRY CLUB BOULEVARD IN SAN JOAQUIN COUNTY

San Joaquin County – The California Department of Transportation (Caltrans) will perform various road construction and maintenance activities on Interstate 5 (I-5) from Manthey/Mosssdale Roads to Pershing Avenue. No two consecutive ramps will close at the same time. Work will occur as follows: (No road work is scheduled on Thursday, November 27, 2014, and Friday, November 28, 2014)

- The #1 (left), #2 (middle left) and #3 (middle) lanes on northbound I-5 at Manthey/Mosssdale Roads will close beginning Monday, December 22, 2014 through Wednesday, December 24, 2014 from 8:00 p.m. until 6:00 a.m.;
- The #1(left) and #2 (middle) lanes on southbound I-5 at Roth Road will close beginning Monday, December 22, 2014, through Wednesday, December 24, 2014, from 8:00 p.m. until 5:00 a.m.;
- The #1(left) and #2 (middle) lanes on southbound I-5 at Mathews Road will close beginning Monday, December 22, 2014, through Wednesday, December 24, 2014, from 8:00 p.m. until 5:00 a.m.;
- The northbound on-ramp at Downing Avenue to I-5 will close Monday, December 22, 2014, from 9:00 a.m. until 2:00 p.m.;
- The northbound on-ramp at Downing Avenue to I-5 will close beginning Monday, December 22, 2014, through Wednesday, December 24, 2014, from 9:00 p.m. until 6:00 a.m.;
- The #1(left) and #2 (middle) lanes on northbound I-5 at Walker Slough will close beginning Monday, December 22, 2014, through Wednesday, December 24, 2014, from 9:00 p.m. until 6:00 a.m.;
- The off-ramp on northbound I-5 at Pershing Avenue will close Monday, December 22, 2014, from 9:00 a.m. until 1:00 p.m.
