TRAFFIC ADVISORY STATE ROUTE 99 FROM MARIPOSA ROAD TO STATE ROUTE 4/CROSTOWN FREEWAY IN STOCKTON

Stockton - The California Department of Transportation (Caltrans) will restrict lanes and ramps on State Route 99 (SR-99) from Mariposa Road to SR-4 West/Crosstown Freeway for highway construction. No two consecutive ramps will close at the same time. Work will occur as follows:

- The northbound on-ramp from Mariposa Road to SR-99 will close beginning Monday, February 10, 2014, through Friday, February 14, 2014, from 9:00 p.m. until 4:00 a.m.;
- The northbound and southbound on and off-ramps from SR-4/Farmington Road to SR-99 will close beginning Monday, February 10, 2014, through Friday, February 14, 2014, from 9:00 p.m. until 4:00 a.m.;
- The #1 (left) and #2 (right) lanes on northbound and southbound SR-99 from Mariposa Road to SR-4 West/Crosstown Freeway will alternately close beginning Monday, February 10, 2014, through Friday, February 14, 2014, from 9:00 p.m. until 5:00 a.m.

Motorists should expect 10 minute delays. Alternate routes should be taken whenever possible.

This work is scheduled to begin as listed, but is subject to change due to traffic incidents, weather, availability of equipment and/or materials and construction related issues.
