TRAFFIC ADVISORY STATE ROUTE 99 FROM AUSTIN ROAD TO STATE ROUTE 26/FREMONT STREET IN SAN JOAQUIN COUNTY

San Joaquin County – The California Department of Transportation (Caltrans) will perform various road construction and maintenance activities on State Route 99 (SR-99) from Austin Road to SR-26/Fremont Street. No two consecutive ramps will close at the same time. Work will occur as follows:

- The #1 (left) and #2 (right) lanes, left and right shoulders and median on northbound and southbound SR-99 from Austin Road to Arch Road will alternately close beginning Monday, July 7, 2014, through Friday, July 11, 2014, from 8:00 p.m. until 5:00 a.m.;
- French Camp Road under SR-99 will close beginning Monday, July 7, 2014, through Friday, July 11, 2014, from 8:00 p.m. until 5:00 a.m.;
- The northbound off-ramp from SR-99 to French Camp Road is closed and scheduled to reopen spring 2015;
- The #1 (left) and #2 (right) lanes on northbound and southbound SR-99 from Arch Road to SR-4/Crosstown Freeway will alternately close beginning Monday, July 7, 2014, through Friday, July 11, 2014, from 9:00 p.m. until 5:00 a.m.;
- The connector ramp on northbound SR-99 from SR-4/Crosstown Freeway to SR-26/Fremont Street will close on Tuesday, July 8, 2014, from 9:00 a.m. until 12:00 p.m. (noon).

Motorists should expect 15 minute delays. Alternate routes should be taken whenever possible.

This work is scheduled to begin as listed, but is subject to change due to traffic incidents, weather, availability of equipment and/or materials, and construction related issues.
