### TRAFFIC ADVISORY STATE ROUTE 99 FROM FRENCH CAMP ROAD TO LIBERTY ROAD IN SAN JOAQUIN COUNTY

**San Joaquin County** – The California Department of Transportation (Caltrans) will perform various road construction and maintenance activities on State Route 99 (SR-99) from French Camp Road to Liberty Road. No two consecutive ramps will close at the same time. Work will occur as follows:

- The southbound on-ramp from French Camp Road to SR-99 is closed and scheduled to reopen June 23, 2014;
- The northbound off-ramp from SR-99 to French Camp Road is scheduled to close the week of June 23, 2014, and reopen Spring 2015;
- The #1 (left) and #2 (right) lanes on northbound and southbound SR-99 from Arch Road to SR-4/Crosstown Freeway will alternately close beginning Sunday, June 15, 2014, through Friday, June 20, 2014, from 10:00 p.m. until 5:00 a.m.;
- The #1 (left) and #2 (middle) lanes on northbound SR-99 from Eight Mile Road to Armstrong Road will close beginning Tuesday, June 17, 2014, at 10:00 p.m. through Wednesday, June 18, 2014, at 5:00 a.m.;
- Crews will perform a moving closure in the #1 (left) lane and the left and right shoulders on northbound SR-99 at Liberty Road beginning Monday, June 16, 2014, through Tuesday, June 17, 2014, from 8:30 a.m. until 2:00 p.m.

Motorists should expect 10 minute delays. Alternate routes should be taken whenever possible.

This work is scheduled to begin as listed, but is subject to change due to traffic incidents, weather, availability of equipment and/or materials, and construction related issues.
