### **TRAFFIC ADVISORY STATE ROUTE 99 FROM AUSTIN ROAD TO STATE ROUTE 4/CROSSTOWN FREEWAY IN SAN JOAQUIN COUNTY**

**San Joaquin County** – The California Department of Transportation (Caltrans) will perform various road construction and maintenance activities on State Route 99 (SR-99) from Austin Road to SR-4/Crosstown Freeway. No two consecutive ramps will close at the same time. Work will occur as follows:

- The northbound and southbound on and off-ramps at Austin Road will alternately close beginning Monday, May 12, 2014, through Friday, May 16, 2014, from 9:00 p.m. until 6:00 a.m.;
- The #1 (left) lane, left shoulder and median on northbound and southbound SR-99 from Arch Road to SR-120 West/Manteca Bypass will close beginning Monday, May 12, 2014, through Friday, May 16, 2014, from 8:00 p.m. until 5:00 a.m.;
- The #1 (left) and #2 (right) lanes on northbound and southbound SR-99 from Arch Road to SR-4/Crosstown Freeway will alternately close beginning Monday, May 12, 2014, through Friday, May 16, 2014, from 9:00 p.m. until 5:00 a.m.;
- The connector ramp from eastbound SR-120 to southbound SR-99 will close beginning Monday, May 12, 2014, through Friday, May 16, 2014, from 10:00 p.m. until 5:00 a.m.

Motorists should expect 10 minute delays. Alternate routes should be taken whenever possible.

This work is scheduled to begin as listed, but is subject to change due to traffic incidents, weather, availability of equipment and/or materials, and construction related issues.
