TRAFFIC ADVISORY NEW THREE-WAY STOP SIGN INTERSECTION AT SULTANA DRIVE/ LIBERTY AVENUE IN MERCED COUNTY

Merced County – The California Department of Transportation (Caltrans) will install two stop signs on Sultana Drive/ Liberty Avenue heading eastbound and westbound at the intersection of the on and off-ramps for State Route 99 (SR-99) on Tuesday, June 10, 2014.

Crews will also install “Stop Ahead” signs on Sultana Drive/ Liberty Avenue in the eastbound and westbound directions warning motorists of the upcoming stop signs.

Originally, Caltrans placed a stop sign at the intersection coming off the northbound off-ramp from SR-99 to Sultana Drive/ Liberty Avenue; however, the additional stop signs will change the northbound ramp intersection from a single stop into a three-way stop intersection.

The stop sign installation is scheduled to begin as listed, but is subject to change due to traffic incidents, weather, availability of equipment and/ or materials, and construction related issues.
