TRAFFIC ADVISORY INTERSTATE 5 FROM ROTH ROAD TO HAMMER LANE IN SAN JOAQUIN COUNTY

San Joaquin County – The California Department of Transportation (Caltrans) will perform various road construction and maintenance activities on Interstate 5 (I-5) from Roth Road to Hammer Lane. No two consecutive ramps will close at the same time. Work will occur as follows:

- The #1(left) and #2 (middle) lanes on southbound I-5 at Roth Road will alternately close beginning Sunday, November 16, 2014, through Friday, November 21, 2014, from 8:00 p.m. until 5:00 a.m.;
- The #1(left) and #2 (middle) lanes on southbound I-5 at Mathews Road will close beginning Sunday, November 16, 2014, through Friday, November 21, 2014, from 8:00 p.m. until 5:00 a.m.;
- The northbound on-ramp from Downing Avenue to I-5 will close beginning Sunday, November 16, 2014, through Friday, November 21, 2014, from 9:00 p.m. until 6:00 a.m.;
- The #1(left) and #2 (middle) lanes on northbound I-5 at Walker Slough will close beginning Sunday, November 16, 2014, through Friday, November 21, 2014, from 9:00 p.m. until 6:00 a.m.;
- The #1 (left), #2 (middle) and #3 (right) lanes, and right shoulder on northbound and southbound I-5 from State Route 4/Charter Way to Country Club Boulevard will alternately close beginning Sunday, November 16, 2014, through Friday, November 21, 2014, from 9:00 p.m. until 5:00 a.m.;
- The # 3 (right) lane on northbound and southbound I-5 from Country Club Boulevard to Hammer Lane will alternately close beginning Sunday, November 16, 2014, through Friday, November 21, 2014, from 8:00 p.m. until 6:00 a.m.;

- The northbound on and off-ramps from Alpine Avenue through Hammer Lane will close beginning Sunday, November 16, 2014, through Friday, November 21, 2014, from 8:00 p.m. until 5:00 a.m.;
- The connector ramps at northbound and southbound I-5 and eastbound and westbound SR-4/Crosstown Freeway will alternately close beginning Sunday, November 16, 2014, through Friday, November 21, 2014, from 10:00 p.m. until 5:00 a.m.

Motorists should expect 10 minute delays. Alternate routes should be taken whenever possible.

This work is scheduled to begin as listed, but is subject to change due to traffic incidents, weather, availability of equipment and/or materials, and construction related issues.
