### **TRAFFIC ADVISORY INTERSTATE 5 FROM FRENCH CAMP ROAD TO HAMMER LANE IN SAN JOAQUIN COUNTY**

**San Joaquin County** – The California Department of Transportation (Caltrans) will perform various road construction and maintenance activities on Interstate 5 (I-5) from French Camp Road to Hammer Lane. No two consecutive ramps will close at the same time. Work will occur as follows:

- The northbound and southbound on and off-ramps on I-5 at French Camp Road will alternately close beginning Sunday, October 12, 2014, through Friday, October 17, 2014, from 8:00 p.m. until 6:00 a.m.;
- The on-ramp from Downing Avenue to northbound I-5 will close beginning Sunday, October 12, 2014, through Friday, October 17, 2014, from 9:00 p.m. until 6:00 a.m.;
- The #1(left) and #2 (middle) lanes on northbound I-5 at Walker Slough will close beginning Sunday, October 12, 2014, through Friday, October 17, 2014, from 9:00 p.m. until 6:00 a.m.;
- The #1 (left), #2 (middle) and #3 (right) lanes, and right shoulder on northbound and southbound I-5 from SR-4/Charter Way to Country Club Boulevard will alternately close beginning Monday, October 13, 2014, through Friday, October 17, 2014, from 9:00 p.m. until 5:00 a.m.;
- The northbound on and off-ramps on I-5 from March Lane to Hammer Lane will alternately close from Sunday, October 12, 2014, to Monday, October 13, 2014, from 8:00 p.m. until 5:00 a.m.;
- The on and off-ramps on northbound and southbound I-5 from SR-4/Charter Way to Country Club Boulevard will alternately close beginning Monday, October 13, 2014, through Friday, October 17, 2014, from 9:00 p.m. until 5:00 a.m.;

- The connector ramps at northbound and southbound I-5 and eastbound and westbound SR-4/Crosstown Freeway will alternately close beginning Monday, October 13, 2014, through Friday, October 17, 2014, from 10:00 p.m. until 5:00 a.m.

Motorists should expect 10 minute delays. Alternate routes should be taken whenever possible.

This work is scheduled to begin as listed, but is subject to change due to traffic incidents, weather, availability of equipment and/or materials, and construction related issues.
