### **TRAFFIC ADVISORY INTERSTATE 5 FROM DOWNING AVENUE TO MARCH LANE IN SAN JOAQUIN COUNTY**

**San Joaquin County** – The California Department of Transportation (Caltrans) will perform various road construction and maintenance activities on Interstate 5 (I-5) from Downing Avenue to March Lane. No two consecutive ramps will close at the same time. Work will occur as follows:

- The on-ramp from Downing Avenue to northbound I-5 will close beginning Sunday, September 7, 2014, through Friday, September 12, 2014, from 9:00 p.m. until 6:00 a.m.;
- The #1(left) and #2 (middle) lanes on northbound I-5 at Walker Slough will close beginning Sunday, September 7, 2014, through Friday, September 12, 2014, from 9:00 p.m. until 6:00 a.m.;
- The southbound off-ramp from I-5 to State Route 4 (SR-4)/Charter Way is closed and scheduled to reopen Tuesday, September 16, 2014.;
- The #1 (left), #2 (middle) and #3 (right) lanes on northbound and southbound I-5 from SR-4/Charter Way to Country Club Boulevard will alternately close beginning Sunday, September 7, 2014, through Saturday, September 13, 2014, from 9:00 p.m. until 5:00 a.m.;
- The connector ramps at northbound and southbound I-5 and eastbound and westbound SR-4/Crosstown Freeway will close beginning Sunday, September 7, 2014, through Saturday, September 13, 2014, from 10:00 p.m. until 5:00 a.m.;
- The northbound and southbound on and off-ramps on I-5 from SR-4/Charter Way to Country Club Boulevard will close beginning Sunday, September 7, 2014, through Saturday, September 12, 2014, from 9:00 p.m. until 5:00 a.m.;
- The northbound I-5 on and off-ramp at March Lane will close beginning Sunday, September 7, 2014, through Thursday, September 11, 2014 from 8:00 p.m. until 5:00 a.m.
