### TRAFFIC ADVISORY STATE ROUTE 99 FROM AUSTIN ROAD TO ARCH ROAD IN SAN JOAQUIN COUNTY

**San Joaquin County** – The California Department of Transportation (Caltrans) will perform various road construction and maintenance activities on State Route 99 (SR-99) from Austin Road to Arch Road. No two consecutive ramps will close at the same time. Work will occur as follows:

- The #1 (left) and #2 (middle) lanes, left shoulder and median on northbound and southbound SR-99 from Austin Road to Arch Road will close beginning Sunday September 7, 2014 through Friday September 12, 2014 from 7:00 p.m. until 6:00 a.m.;
- The #2 (left) lane on northbound and southbound SR-99 from State Route 120 North/Yosemite Avenue to French Camp will close beginning Sunday, September 7, 2014, through Friday, September 12, 2014, from 8:00 p.m. until 5:00 a.m.;
- The off-ramp on southbound SR-99 at North Manteca/ Main street will close beginning Sunday, September 7, 2014, through Friday, September 12, 2014, from 9:00 p.m. until 5:00 a.m.;
- The on and off-ramps on northbound and southbound SR-99 at Lathrop Road will close Sunday, September 7, 2014, at 9:00 p.m. until Monday, September 8, 2014, at 5:00 a.m.;
- The northbound off-ramp from SR-99 to French Camp Road is closed and scheduled to reopen spring 2015;
- The right shoulder, and #2 (right) lane on southbound SR-99 from San Joaquin/Sacramento County Line to Liberty Road will close beginning Monday, September 8, 2014, through Friday, September 12, 2014, from 9:00 a.m. until 2:00 p.m.
