TRAFFIC ADVISORY INTERSTATE 5 TRAFFIC SHIFT FROM CHARTER WAY TO PERSHING AVENUE IN STOCKTON

Stockton – Motorists can expect a shift in traffic lanes on northbound Interstate 5 (I-5) from Charter Way to Pershing Avenue for construction activities. The lane shift is scheduled to be in place for approximately three months.

The California Department of Transportation (Caltrans) will perform the lane shift on Wednesday, August 12, 2015, after 4:00 a.m.

The #1 (left) and #2 (middle) lanes on northbound I-5 will be detoured onto the southbound traffic lanes of the interstate. Northbound motorists must stay in the #3 (right) lane for on and off-ramp access to State Route 4 / Crosstown Freeway, Pershing Avenue, and Monte Diablo Avenue.

The lane shift is part of the \$46 million I-5 Rehabilitation Project. Crews are replacing the existing roadway, which will improve pavement life and provide a smoother driving surface.

Morning commuters should be alert to changes in the road the day of the shift. Alternate routes should be taken whenever possible.

This work is scheduled to begin as listed, but is subject to change due to traffic incidents, weather, availability of equipment and/or materials, and construction related issues.
