TRAFFIC ADVISORY INTERSTATE 5 FROM STATE ROUTE 4/CROSTOWN FREEWAY TO TURNER ROAD IN SAN JOAQUIN COUNTY

San Joaquin County – The California Department of Transportation (Caltrans) will perform various road construction and bridge activities on Interstate 5 (I-5) from State Route 4(SR-4) /Crosstown Freeway to Turner Road. Work will occur as follows:

- The #1(left), #2 (middle) and #3 (right) lanes on northbound and southbound I-5 from SR-4/Charter Way to Country Club Boulevard will alternately close beginning Sunday, October 25, 2015, through Friday, October 30, 2015, from 9:00 p.m. until 5:00 a.m.;
- The connector ramps from northbound and southbound I-5 to SR-4/Crosstown Freeway will alternately close beginning Sunday, October 25, 2015, through Friday, October 30, 2015, from 10:00 p.m. until 5:00 a.m.;
- The northbound and southbound on and off-ramps on I-5 from SR-4/Charter way to Country Club Boulevard will alternately close beginning Sunday, October 25, 2015, through Friday, October 30, 2015, from 9:00 p.m. until 5:00 a.m.;
- The southbound on and off-ramps on I-5 from Alpine Avenue to March Lane will alternately close beginning Sunday, October 25, 2015, through Friday, October 30, 2015, from 8:00 p.m. until 5:00 a.m.;
- The #3 (right) lane on southbound I-5 from Alpine Avenue to March Lane will alternately close beginning Sunday, October 25, 2015, through Friday, October 30, 2015, from 8:00 p.m. until 5:00 a.m.;
- The northbound off-ramp from I-5 to Turner Road will close beginning Monday, October 26, 2015, through Wednesday, October 28, 2015, from 9:00 p.m. until 6:00 a.m.
