TRAFFIC ADVISORY INTERSTATE 5 FROM NORTH VISTA POINT TO SPERRY ROAD IN STANISLAUS COUNTY

Stanislaus County – The California Department of Transportation (Caltrans) will alternately close various northbound and southbound on and off-ramps on Interstate 5 from North Vista Point to Sperry Road for paving.

Work is scheduled to begin Sunday, November 1, 2015, through Friday, November 6, 2015, from 8:00 p.m. until 5:00 a.m.

Motorists should expect 15 minute delays. Alternate routes should be taken whenever possible.

This work is scheduled to begin as listed, but is subject to change due to traffic incidents, weather, availability of equipment and/ or materials and construction related issues.

This is part of the Interstate 5 Repaving and Rehabilitation Project, a \$51 million effort that will repave 40 miles of I-5 in Merced, Stanislaus and San Joaquin counties. Work began in April 2015 and is scheduled to finish in April 2016. The project extends from Tom Paine Slough in San Joaquin County, just north of the I-205 interchange, to just south of the Merced/Stanislaus County line. The project also is installing in-ground detections loops and paving on and off-ramps so they conform smoothly with local roads.
