TRAFFIC ADVISORY STATE ROUTE 4/CROSTOWN FREEWAY FROM STANISLAUS STREET TO STATE ROUTE 99

San Joaquin County – The California Department of Transportation (Caltrans) will perform various road construction activities on State Route 4(SR-4)/Crosstown Freeway from Stanislaus Street to SR-99.

- The eastbound and westbound on and off-ramps from Stanislaus Street to Filbert Street will alternately close beginning Sunday, August 14, 2016, through Friday, August 19, 2016, from 7:00 p.m. until 6:00 a.m.;
- The #1 (left) and #2 (middle) lanes on SR-4/Crosstown Freeway from Airport Way to SR-99 will close beginning Sunday, August 14, 2016, through Friday, August 19, 2016, from 7:00 p.m. until 6:00 a.m.;
- The eastbound off-ramp from SR-4/Crosstown Freeway to Wilson Way will close beginning Sunday, August 14, 2016 through Friday, August 19, 2016 , From 8:00p.m. until 6:00 a.m.

Motorists should expect 10 minute delays. Alternate routes should be taken whenever possible.

This work is scheduled to begin as listed, but is subject to change due to traffic incidents, weather, availability of equipment and/ or materials and construction related issues.
