### CONSTRUCTION ADVISORY CALTRANS PAVING STATE ROUTE 4 IN CALAVERAS COUNTY

**Calaveras County** – The California Department of Transportation (Caltrans) is preparing to begin work on a project that will pave 21 miles of roadway on State Route 4 (SR-4) from the Calaveras/Stanislaus County line to West SR-49 in Angels Camp.

The project is a maintenance overlay for pavement preservation, which typically extends roadway surface life for three to five years.

Work is scheduled to begin the week of August 22, 2016, and be completed in October, 2016.

One-way traffic control will be used and drivers should expect 15-minute delays. Work is scheduled to be done during the day, Monday through Friday, from 6:00 a.m. until 4:00 p.m.

This \$5.1 million project has been awarded to George Reed Construction, Inc.

Work is scheduled to begin as listed, but is subject to change due to traffic incidents, weather, availability of equipment and/or materials and construction related issues.
