CONSTRUCTION ADVISORY CALTRANS PAVING STATE ROUTE 88 IN AMADOR COUNTY

Amador County – The California Department of Transportation (Caltrans) is preparing to begin work on a project that will pave over seven miles of roadway on State Route 88 from one mile east of Cat Creek Road to Foster Meadow Road in Amador County.

The project is a maintenance overlay for pavement preservation, which typically extends roadway surface life for three to five years.

Work is scheduled to begin Monday, June 13, 2016, and be completed in October 2016.

One-way traffic control will be used and drivers should expect 10-minute delays. Work is scheduled to be done during the day and night, Sunday evening through Friday, from 7:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m. and 8:00 p.m. to 6:00 a.m.

This \$7.3 million project has been awarded to George Reed, Inc.

Work is scheduled to begin as listed, but is subject to change due to traffic incidents, weather, availability of equipment and/or materials and construction related issues.
