## **TRAFFIC ADVISORY INTERSTATE 5 FROM SAN JOAQUIN RIVER BRIDGE TO ALPINE AVENUE IN SAN JOAQUIN COUNTY**

**San Joaquin County** – The California Department of Transportation (Caltrans) will perform various road construction activities on Interstate 5 (I-5) from San Joaquin River Bridge to Alpine Avenue. Work will occur as follows:

- The #1(left) lane on southbound I-5 at the San Joaquin River Bridge will be closed on Sunday, March 13, 2016, from noon until 2:30 p.m.;
- The #1 (left), #3 (right) lanes, right and left shoulders on northbound and southbound I-5 from San Joaquin River Bridge to State Route (SR-4) /Charter Way will alternately close beginning Monday, March 14, 2016, through Thursday, March 17, 2016, from 8:00 a.m. until 3:00 p.m.;
- The #1 (left), #2 (middle),#3 (right) lanes, right and left shoulders on northbound and southbound I-5 from French Camp Slough to Alpine Avenue will alternately close beginning Sunday, March 13, 2016, through Friday, March 18, 2016, from 8:00 p.m. until 6:00 a.m.;
- The #1 (left), #2 (middle),#3 (right) lanes on northbound and southbound I-5 from SR-4/Charter Way to Country Club Boulevard will alternately close beginning Sunday, March 13, 2016, through Friday, March 18, 2016, from 9:00 p.m. until 5:00 a.m.;
- The northbound and southbound on and off-ramps on I-5 from SR-4/Charter Way to Country Club Boulevard will alternately close from Sunday, March 13, 2016, through Friday, March 18, 2016, from 8:00 p.m. until 5:00 a.m.;
- The northbound and southbound connector ramps from I-5 to SR-4/Crosstown Freeway will alternately close from Sunday, March 13, 2016, through Friday, March 18, 2016, from 10:00 p.m. until 5:00 a.m.
