TRAFFIC ADVISORY STATE ROUTE 99 FROM ARCH ROAD TO HAMMER LANE IN SAN JOAQUIN COUNTY

San Joaquin County – The California Department of Transportation (Caltrans) will perform various road construction on State Route 99 (SR-99) from Arch Road to Hammer Lane. No two consecutive ramps will close at the same time. Work will occur as follows:

- The #1 (left) and #2 (right) lanes on both northbound and southbound SR-99 from Arch Road to SR-4/Crosstown Freeway will alternately close beginning Sunday, October 2, 2016, through Friday, October 7, 2016, from 11:00 p.m. until 5:00 a.m.;
- The northbound and southbound on and off-ramps, and the overcrossing at Mariposa Road are closed and scheduled to reopen fall 2016;
- The northbound and southbound on and off-ramps from SR-99 to Golden Gate Avenue will close beginning Sunday, October 2, 2016, through Friday, October 7, 2016, from 8:00 p.m. until 5:00 a.m.;
- The northbound and southbound connector ramp from SR-99 to SR-4/Crosstown Freeway will close beginning Sunday, October 2, 2016, through Friday, October 7, 2016, from 9:00 p.m. until 5:00 a.m.;
- The #2 (middle), #3 (right) lanes on northbound and southbound SR-99 from Hammer Lane to Marsh Street Pedestrian Overcrossing will alternately close beginning Sunday, October 2, 2016, through Friday, October 7, 2016, from 8:00 p.m. until 6:00 a.m.;

Motorists should expect 10 minute delays. Alternate routes should be taken whenever possible.

This work is scheduled to begin as listed, but is subject to change due to traffic incidents, weather, availability of equipment and/or materials, and construction related issues.
