## **TRAFFIC ADVISORY INTERSTATE 5 FROM DOWNING AVENUE TO MONTE DIABLO AVENUE IN SAN JOAQUIN COUNTY**

**San Joaquin County** – The California Department of Transportation (Caltrans) will perform various road construction activities on Interstate 5 (I-5) from Downing Avenue to Monte Diablo Avenue. Work will occur as follows:

- The #1 (left), #2 (middle), #3 (right) lanes on northbound and southbound I-5 from Downing Avenue to State Route 4/Charter Way will alternately close beginning Sunday, April 10, 2016, through Friday, April 15, 2016, from 9:00 p.m. until 6:00 a.m.;
- The northbound and southbound on and off-ramps on I-5 from Charter Way to Downing Avenue will alternately close from Sunday, April 10, 2016, through Friday, April 15, 2016, from 9:00 p.m. until 5:00 a.m.;
- The northbound and southbound connector ramps from I-5 to SR-4/Crosstown Freeway will alternately close from Sunday, April 10, 2016, through Friday, April 15, 2016, from 10:00 p.m. until 5:00 a.m.;
- The #1 (left), #2 (middle), #3 (right) lanes on northbound and southbound I-5 from Pershing Avenue to Alpine Avenue will alternately close beginning Sunday, April 10, 2016, through Friday, April 15, 2016, from 9:00 p.m. until 6:00 a.m.;
- The northbound and southbound on and off-ramps on I-5 from Pershing Avenue to Alpine Avenue will alternately close from Sunday, April 10, 2016, through Friday, April 15, 2016, from 9:00 p.m. until 5:00 a.m.;
- The #1 (left), #2 (middle), #3 (right) lanes on southbound I-5 from Alpine Avenue to Monte Diablo Avenue will alternately close beginning Friday, April 15, 2016, through Sunday, April 17, 2016, from 8:00 p.m. until 6:00 a.m.
