Construction Work in North Sacramento to Close Winters Street On-ramp
Interstate 80 Across the Top

SACRAMENTO – The California Department of Transportation (Caltrans) is advising motorists that the Winters Street On-ramp to westbound Interstate 80 will be closed for 15 days due to construction work in North Sacramento beginning Friday, October 9.

The roadwork is part of the ongoing “80 Across the Top” project that covers approximately 10 miles from the Sacramento River to Watt Avenue. West and eastbound motorists can also expect lane restrictions and multiple freeway entrances and exits to be shut down from evening hours to the next morning.

The staging of equipment, safety lighting, and cone placement will begin by 8 p.m. and the Winters Street on-ramp will be closed from **10 p.m. Friday, October 9 through 2 p.m. Saturday, October 24**. Traffic for this on-ramp will be detoured to eastbound I-80 and then onto Longview drive and back onto westbound I-80 for access.

Local cross streets for this ramp will remain open for northbound and southbound directions. Caltrans advises motorists to plan for additional travel time or to use alternate routes.

Local residents may experience nighttime construction noise including jack hammer type and commercial truck beeping.

Motorists are reminded to “Be Work Zone Alert” and “Slow for the Cone Zone”
