Nighttime Closures Scheduled for North Sacramento I-80 and I-5 Connector

Interstate 80 Across the Top

SACRAMENTO – The California Department of Transportation (Caltrans) is advising motorists that the Northgate Boulevard and Truxel Road on- and off ramps to westbound Interstate 80 and the connector ramps to Interstate 5 will be closed at night for continued construction work in North Sacramento beginning **Monday, May 23 through Friday, May 27 from 9 p.m. – 6 a.m.**

A detour route will be available for westbound I-80 motorists wanting to exit onto north- or southbound I-5 and the closed overpasses. These will be alternating closures and no two consecutive ramps will be closed at one time. Caltrans expects there to be delays and urges motorists to plan for additional travel time or to use alternate routes. Local cross streets will remain open for north- and southbound directions.

DETOUR

- Continue westbound on I-80 and exit at West El Camino Avenue.
- Make a left turn at West El Camino and use the eastbound I-80 loop on-ramp to get back to the I-5 interchange or Truxel Road or Northgate Boulevard.

The roadwork is part of the ongoing “80 Across the Top” project that covers approximately 10 miles from the Sacramento River to Watt Avenue. West- and eastbound motorists also can expect right lane and shoulder restrictions with most work behind k-rail.

Local residents may experience nighttime construction noise including jack hammer type and commercial truck beeping.

Motorists are reminded to “Be Work Zone Alert” and “Slow for the Cone Zone”
