South Fork American River Bridge Widening Project

WHAT IS BEING PROPOSED

The Department of Transportation (Caltrans) proposes to replace the South Fork American River Bridge on State Route 49 in El Dorado County to meet current seismic standards. The bridge requires mainline shift of the roadway to maintain public access through the project. The project will incorporate other upgrades as appropriate including retaining walls, standard shoulders, lanes, and sidewalks to accommodate bicycles and pedestrians. The bridge replacement will require stage construction that will affect the motoring public, pedestrians and the use of the river during construction.

Residents, business owners and commuters are encouraged to attend and get information on the proposed project. Information pertaining to the proposed architectural features and impacts to motor vehicle and pedestrian access during construction will be available at the meeting.
