**Paint Project Beginning for the Three Mile Slough Bridge on State Highway 160**

RIO VISTA – A project to paint the Three Mile Slough Bridge is in its earliest stages beginning this week and into next week with scheduled electrical work.

Motorists travelling along State Highway 160 can expect delays at the bridge near Rio Vista **Monday, September 14 through Friday, September 18 from 9 a.m. to 3 p.m.**



The bridge will remain open, but one way traffic control will be in effect with flaggers present.

The Three Mile Slough Bridge or Bridge number 24-0121 will be painted over the next year to maintain and preserve one of the bridges that connects Sacramento County with Solano County in the delta region. The work will help prevent deterioration on the bridge steel structural members, and the mechanical components of the operating lift system. Although the estimated \$10.2 million project started this week painting is expected to be done in three stages and completed by the fall of 2016.

To avoid these delays motorists are urged to look for an alternative route or to use another mode of transportation.


