Waterway Traffic Limited at Three-Mile Slough Bridge

Highway 160 Three-Mile Slough Bridge Paint Project

SACRAMENTO COUNTY – The California Department of Transportation (Caltrans) continues work on the estimated \$12.6 million paint project for the Three-Mile Slough Bridge on State Highway 160 south of Rio Vista and Highway 12.

Motorists are advised that one-way traffic control using signals with cameras remains in effect for north- and southbound traffic travelling on Highway 160 at the bridge. Expect significant delays during peak morning and afternoon commute hours.


